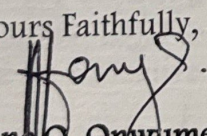

**RE-CONSTITUTION OF NATIONAL STAKEHOLDERS WORKING GROUP (NSWG):
REQUEST FOR CSO CONSTITUENCY NOMINATION.**

1. In line with section (3) of the Policy Guidelines on Appointment/ Nomination of Civil Society Representative on National Stakeholders Working Group (NSWG), I have been directed to inform you that NEITI has received notification from the presidency that the process of constitution of the National Stakeholders Working Group (NEITI Board) has commenced.
2. In the letter from the Office of the Secretary to the Government of the Federation (OSGF) received in NEITI on Thursday 15th February 2024, the Presidency has requested NEITI to bring this development to the attention of stakeholders "the Civil Society constituency to nominate/elect their representative and forward the relevant details to the OSGF as soon as possible".
3. We therefore request that you promptly bring this notification to the attention of the wider Civil Society Organizations working in the extractive sector for necessary action.
4. In line with section (3d) of the guidelines in reference above, NEITI also requests that the documentary evidence attesting to the openness, inclusiveness and independence of the process for the selection of the nominee must be compiled and sent alongside the letter communicating the name of the nominee, directly to the Office of the Secretary to the Government of the Federation and notify NEITI of compliance.
5. Please treat as urgent.
