Thanks for this enquiry. I would be happy to follow this up with my colleagues Andy Irvine and Mark Burnett who lead on Outreach. We are available for a call with Seplat Energy to explain this in better detail.

I have attached the company constituency guidelines that outlines how a company can become an EITI supporting company. A summary is below:

An interested company must complete the sign-up process published by the EITI International Secretariat ("Secretariat") on the EITI website. As part of the sign-up process for EITI supporting companies:

- The Secretariat shall conduct basic due diligence on the new supporting company and inform the Company Constituency about the company before sign-up;
- The Secretariat shall perform a review of the new company's progress against the Expectations for EITI supporting companies ("Expectations"), as published on the EITI website, and inform the company of the results of the review;
- Senior management of the new supporting company shall sign a statement of support for the EITI and commitment to the Expectations; and

- The new supporting company shall make an annual financial contribution to the international management of the EITI ("annual membership fee") in the amount published on the EITI website.
- New supporting companies (those that are not already supporters of the EITI as of the date of these guidelines) are expected to sign a commitment to the Expectations but are not expected to meet the Expectations at the outset. All EITI supporting companies and financial institutions should encourage and help facilitate the implementation of the EITI in countries in which they operate.

I write to enquire on the requirements for entities that want to join the EITI as supporting companies.

Specifically, I got these questions from an indigenous oil and gas company:

1. What are the registration requirements for an oil and gas company.
2. Do we need to register with the EITI?
3. What is the duration for registration.
4. Contact details of personnel to liaise with until the registration is completed.

Seplat energy is an indigenous oil and gas company listed on the Nigerian stock exchange and the London Exchange. It is the only indigenous oil and gas company that has the status of being listed on both the Nigerian Exchange and the London Stock Exchange.
