### REQUEST FOR INFORMATION

Considering the need to reposition gas as the key driver of the Nigerian economy, the House Committee on Gas Resources is resolute in instituting the appropriate legislative actions to enhance the performance of the gas sector, access to gas and gas penetration for the benefit of the Nigerian populace.

The Committee is aware of the strategic role of NEITI in collating data and enhancing transparency in the record of gas production, payments, and revenue accruable and collected by the Government of Nigeria in the petroleum sector and as such requests that you furnish it with the following information as it relates to the volumes of gas production, utilization, reinjection, flaring and venting:

- detailed information on the companies operating in the petroleum upstream sector (including the oil fields they operate);
- data on the volume of gas volumes produced, flared, vented, reinjected, utilized, and sold by each company from 2016 to date (this should include records of filings made for flaring and venting of gas by each company);
- records of payments made for gas production to Government of Nigeria from 2004 to date;
- statutory penalties or fines imposed on companies for non-compliance with gas flaring, and venting, and evidence of such payments including the payments made for default in filings made by each company;
- Laws governing gas flares, venting, and emissions in Nigeria; and

- f. any other document that could assist the Committee in discharging its mandate.

The data and information should be presented for each company separately. All data should include graphs and quantitative analysis.

Note that all submissions in 30 hard copies and a soft copy, should reach the Committee's Secretariat on or before January 13, 2025, at HB. 48, Basement, White House, House of Representatives, National Assembly Complex, Abuja.

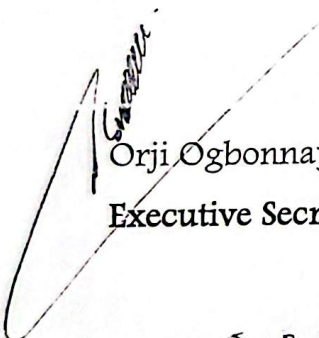
